What do we offer?

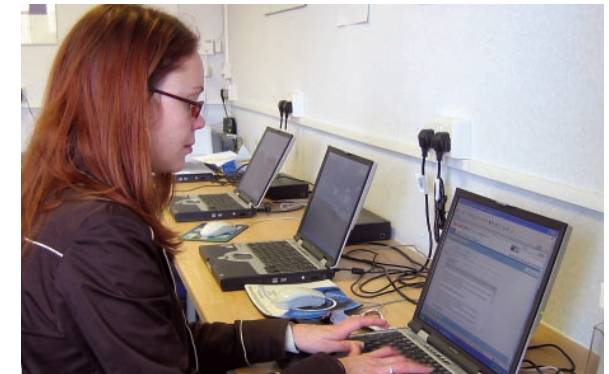
Advice and support with your employment, voluntary and training opportunities including the following:
